THG is keen to hear from artists interested in an exciting and rewarding exhibition opportunity.

We are looking for artists interested in donating a piece of their work to be included in the display at THG, Honiton alongside their 'South West Academy' exhibition. After the exhibition all donated artworks will be professionally auctioned by local auctioneers Bearnas Hampton & Littlewood to raise funds for an exceptional local charitable cause:

Admiral Nurse Campaign- Honiton's Dementia Action Alliance has identified a real need for expert care and support at home for people living with dementia. They are working towards raising a target of £150K to fund their own Admiral Nurse for three years in the first instance. Admiral Nurses are highly skilled registered nurses who provide specialist and compassionate support for people with dementia and their families. Their unique background and experience enables them to work together with families and complimentary to local health and social care services.

When things get challenging or difficult, Admiral Nurses work alongside people with dementia and their families: giving them the one-to-one support, expert guidance and the practical solutions they need, and that can be hard to find elsewhere.

Some of the auction proceeds will also go to THG to help their work with those of all ages living with dementia and other mental health issues. A high quality auction catalogue featuring all of the donated works with artists' contact details will be produced. This catalogue will allow interested buyers not only the opportunity to see who has generously donated work but allow potential clients to contact artists directly. There will also be a live website where commissioned bids can be left with artists' details.



Access

What you need to know if you are going to donate work:

- **We welcome artworks of any interpretation and any medium.**
- **All work must be your own and by submitting an entry form you agree to your work being donated and auctioned.**
- **Submission of entry form (see 'Part 1' below) by Wednesday 25 October 2017**
 Entry form submission must include:
 - title of work
 - dimensions
 - artist name
 - website/email address or phone number (for the catalogue/website).
 - idea of the price you would normally sell the work for to help determine a guide price at auction.
 - a digital photograph of your work for our records only
- **Size and Special Requirements**
 - There is no limit to the size of the work, please bear in mind that THG is a relatively small gallery and the space is limited.
 - Works under 60cm x 60cm would be ideal.
 - It may not be possible to include all work submitted. We will display a maximum of 50 works.
- **Acknowledgment of work**
 - Artists will be informed by email (or phone) by Thursday 2 November if their work will be included or not.
- **Delivery of work**
 - All accepted artworks are to be delivered to THG on Tuesday 5 December 2017 between 10am and 5pm
 - Please attach part 2 of this form to the back of your work before delivery
- **Hanging**
 - Work must be fully dry and ready to hang
 - Clip frames cannot be accepted
 - All framed and wall mounted artwork must be submitted with picture rings and cord/wire, straphangers or mirror plates.
 - The Curator's decision on how and where the artwork is displayed is final.
 - All work will remain on display at THG until the evening of the auction.
- **The Auction**
 - Will take place on Friday 2 March 2018 at 7pm at THG
 - Commissioned bids can be taken throughout the exhibition period
- **Publicity**
 - As well as the auction catalogue and website, publicity will be undertaken by THG and Honiton's Dementia Action Alliance and Bearnas Hampton & Littlewood Auctioneers.
- **Collection of unsold work**
 - Any artists with unsold work will be contacted after the auction to arrange collection.
- **Reminder of Dates:**
 - Wednesday 25 October 2017 – Entry form & image deadline
 - By Thursday 2 November – Artists informed whether work will be included
 - Tuesday 5 December (10am – 5pm) – Artists to deliver work to THG
 - Saturday 10 February – Art Auction Exhibition opens
 - Friday 2 March (7pm) – Art Auction
